Listener Responses to The Word Today

Arabic

A committed listener from Yemen shares how The Word Today program has been a profound influence on his spiritual journey and ministry. He recalls how the program supported him during some of the most challenging times in his life, including a period of imprisonment. The teachings he received not only encouraged him but also fueled his passion for serving others. Reflecting on his experience, he says, "I believe that The Word Today has not just influenced me in the beginning of my journey, it is influencing many others. I am using the TWT program episodes that you send me along with other programs, to help me witness more boldly to others and therefore give them a source to be nourished from for their journey with Jesus Christ." This conviction has driven him to actively engage in ministry work, even after his release, traveling to Cairo for further training and continuing to mentor others. One notable example is a young Yemeni man who, under his guidance, began exploring Christianity more deeply. With the help of The Word Today episodes, he has been able to witness more effectively, providing resources that nourish the spiritual growth of those he mentors. (Yemen)

Awadhi

I am from the Midwest of Nepal, we are backward in all the prerequisites, not have a comfortable life. We are using the radio for entertainment and news. We live in remote and rural areas. I am a housewife, and I am a listener of the TWT-Awadhi radio program. I had the privilege to have listened to the program as my blessing and spiritual benefit for learning. As we people are illiterate, most of the people are uneducated and working in a low level of work and doing farming. So radio program is the only source to learn and ways to receive God's message. Many times, I am unable to attend church because of being far distanced, therefore I try not to skip the program as it comes from FM Stations. Though I am a new believer of Jesus, just being nearly 2 years. I am very willing to give my offering to the radio program.
