Sermon Text: 1 Corinthians 1: 18-31

Afghanistan

"I am 33 years old and married. I have three sons and work for the government. I know enough about our religious affairs. I had no knowledge of Christ and had no faith in anything. I knew nothing about Christ until one of my childhood friends introduced me. I was very hardhearted and upset at the time. When he noticed such things, he invited me to a garden for a conversation in which he discussed the Scriptures. I didn't believe him at first, but I called him one day to find out more. He did me a favour by telling me about salvation. I knew him, and he was trustworthy, so I trusted everything he said. He also told me about The Word Today radio programmes, which have inspired me and transformed my life."

Sri Lanka

"I'm in the army. I've heard of Jesus, but I'm not sure what he means. After following this programme, I felt compelled to learn more about Jesus."

"I'm from a small village. I relocated to the metro area in search of work. Yesterday, I listened to this programme. I recently accepted Jesus as my personal Saviour.
