How a scientist who studies 'super agers' exercises for a longer life

1,000 MILES INLAND

Lubbock Texas is located 990 miles from the Gulf of Mexico. Roadway construction crews near Lubbock dug up giant sloth bones. Supposedly, during the Pleistocene Epoch, about 11,000 years ago, the area near Lubbock was a playa, a flat area where animals could gather. Then, according to evolutionists, they simply died as they fell into water and were covered over time, preserving them. It's a nice story to support Darwinism.

The reality? Fossil graveyards are found across the continents of the world, many well inland, like Lubbock's. Dr. Aaron Pan, executive director of the Museum of Texas Tech, stated, "It is common to find fossils during building or road construction in Texas, especially in the metroplex." Common? Yes, because the Flood buried approximately 98% of all life! Dead critters are in the ground all over the place, but especially in run-off areas called fossil beds.

Typically, not only are terrestrial creatures such as giant sloths recovered, but also lots of aquatic creatures. Normally, giant land creatures are exhumed from a matrix of sea life! I wonder if that will be the case in this instance. If so, it should add to the preponderance of evidence that supports the biblical Flood. Massive numbers of animals on a playa do not all die together, get compacted into a pile, and slowly buried over time. They were wiped out by a water event, rapidly buried and preserved because they were killed and buried rapidly! The paleontological truth is nearly the opposite of the story that is told.

As humans dig more often into the ground, many such fossil sites will be found. They will continue to call into question the received account of secular science and support the biblical Flood theory. Another amazing aspect of such discoveries is the enormity of the creatures. The ancient world was full of giant animals (megafauna) and giant plants (megaflora). The giant sloths were estimated to be of two varieties, one about 9 feet long and weighing approximately 550 pounds, and the larger species 10 feet long and weighing up to 2,200 pounds! The modern sloth is approximately 2.5 feet and weighs between 9-17 pounds. Are you starting to understand that the ancient world, pre-Flood, was radically different than today?
